BIBLICAL COUNSELING

**What is Biblical Counseling?**

(from www.BCDASoCal.org)

"Biblical Counseling is a life on life ministry in which people with real problems are transformed by God's use of His sufficient Word, which are the focal points of counsel.

The results include:

The Bible equips Christians for good works in every situation (2 Timothy 3:16-17) and Scripture is the final authority of truth (Ps 119:160).

Biblical counselors bear the burdens of others (Galatians 6:1-2), seeking to love as Christ loves (1 John 3:16-18).

Christians put hope in God's promises (John 16:33, 1 Corinthians 10:13), James 1:2-4).

God uses His living and active Word to reach and expose the thoughts and intentions of the heart— a depth of the soul not accessible by man (Hebrews 4:12-13).

By God's grace, the person being counseled puts into practice the actions required by the Word (Hebrews 4:15-16).

Simultaneously that Christian becomes more effective disciple of Christ (John 15:8-11).

**The Need**

People in your church get counsel now— from other Christians, clinical therapists, the Bible, the culture, or other sources.

The souls you shepherd need counsel that reflects the biblical theologies of God, man, hope, sin, change, and truth."

**In the Mediterranean and Meridian**

Paul was confident that the Roman believers would be able to engage in this type of counseling as he wrote, "And concerning you, my brethren, I myself also am convinced that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge and able also to **admonish (noutheteo)** [In the Greek (noutheteo) means to instruct, admonish, warn; to have a corrective influence on someone, to impart understanding] one another" (Romans 15:14).

This is a powerful start towards understanding Biblical counseling. God's Word is sufficient for everything in this life. We as the local church can ALL participate in admonishing or counseling one another with God's Word. Are you ready? Ready yourself by studying the scriptures. All of us can be used of God to admonish, encourage, and help one another patiently with the Word of God.
