Passion Week (Jesus' last week)

Passion Week is so named because of the passion with which Jesus willingly went to the cross in order to pay for the sins of His people. Passion Week is described in: Matthew 21-27; Mark 11-15; Luke 19-23; and John 12-19.

Sunday (March 29) POPULARITY

Sends disciples to get donkey
Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem
"Hosanna!"
Weeps over Jerusalem
Jesus enters the Temple and departs
Returns to Bethany for the night

Monday (March 30) AUTHORITY

Leaves Bethany for Jerusalem
Curses the fig tree
Cleanses the Temple
Returns to Bethany for the night

Tuesday (March 31) CONTROVERSY

Leaves Bethany
Examinations in Temple courts
Olivet Discourse
Judas bargains with the Sanhedrin to betray Christ
Jesus returns to Bethany for the night
Anointed by Mary at Bethany

Wednesday (April 1) SILENCE

Thursday (April 2) PREPARATION

Preparation for Passover meal
Washes disciples feet
Judas departs
Lord's Supper instituted
Agony in the Garden of Gethsemane
Judas betrays Christ
To the house of the high priest as Sanhedrin is convened;
Peter's three denials

Friday (April 3) VIOLENCE

Trials 1-6 before Annas, the Sanhedrin, Roman authorities, Pilate and Herod
Jesus is scourged and mocked
"Crucify him!"
Judas hangs himself
Jesus bears his cross and is crucified
7 sayings on the cross
Jesus dies and the Temple veil is torn
Jesus is buried

Saturday (April 4) REST

Pilate grants a guard and sets a seal on the tomb

Sunday (April 5) VICTORY

Jesus rises from the dead!
Mary Magdalene sees Jesus in the garden
Peter and John see the empty tomb
Jesus appears to the town on the road to Emmaus
Jesus appears to his 10 disciples
