"Everything written in the Scriptures was written to teach us, in order that we might have hope through the patience and encouragement which the Scriptures give us." Romans 15:4

In I Peter 2:2, we're encouraged, "Be like newborn babies, always thirsty for the pure spiritual milk, so that by drinking it you may grow up and be saved."

When I learned to experience the Bible this way—thirsting after its promises and growing in its hope—I found true life in its words. I discovered how it made my relationship with Jesus fuller. I no longer wanted to check reading it off my list. Instead, I wanted to absorb it.

Here are steps for how we can get the most out of our daily Bible reading:

PRAY for focus and openness to see what God has for you in his Word.

READ the selected passage of Scripture slowly. Notice words and phrases that stick out to you; reread them.

REFLECT on what God is communicating to you through the Scripture you've read.

RESPOND to the passage. Speak to God directly about what's on your mind and heart. Look for ways to live out what you've uncovered.

ENHANCE your Bible reading with a daily Bible reading guide or with a daily devotional sent to your email.
