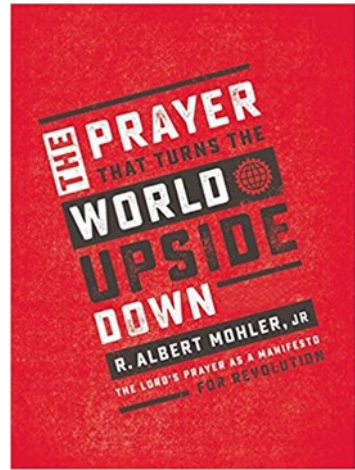

Excerpts from Good Books

"The Prayer That Turns the World Upside Down: The Lord's Prayer as a Manifesto for Revolution" by R. Albert Jr. Mohler



"As already noted, Jesus came preaching the inauguration of the kingdom. His disciples were allowed a glimpse of his kingdom in glory during the

transfiguration (Matt. 17: 2; Mark 9: 2). Jesus' work on the cross is the work of a king who has come to rescue his people. And after his resurrection Jesus declared that he had been given "all authority in heaven and on earth" (Matt. 28: 18). The Great Commission is rooted in Christ's declaration that he is the king on the throne of all creation. In our current stage in redemptive history, therefore, God's kingdom is made up of those who believe in Christ (God's people) gathered in local churches across the world (God's place) under the law of Christ and partaking of the new covenant (God's rule and blessing). Of course, we still wait for the day when this kingdom will be consummated. As of right now, the people of God are at war with spiritual darkness. We are carrying out a commission to make disciples of the king and citizens of the kingdom. And, of course, we can only do so with great suffering and tribulation. Thus, while we are indeed in God's kingdom, we still await God's kingdom in its fullness. We still await the completion of the Great Commission. We still await the coming of the king and the destruction of all wickedness. We long for the day when we will no longer be the church militant, but the church triumphant. Revelation 11: 15 describes just what that day of consummation will bring: "Then the seventh angel blew his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, 'The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and he shall reign forever and ever.'"

"Now we have a few key insights helpful in interpreting this petition—" your kingdom come"—in the Lord's Prayer. God's kingdom is essentially his reign over his people for their good and his glory. God's reign is not just his absolute sovereignty; it is also a redemptive reign that transforms hearts and creates obedience."
