**Cool Bible Study Tools**



Duvall and Hays present a great tool explaining the Interpretive Journey that we must take as we study the Word of God.

**The Interpretive Journey**

**Step 1: Grasp the text in their town.**  
What did the text mean to the original audience?

**Step 2: Measure the width of the river to cross.**

What are the differences between the biblical audience and us?

**Step 3: Cross the principlizing bridge.**  
What is the theological principle in this text?

**Step 4: Consult the biblical map.**  
How does our theological principle fit with the rest of the Bible?

**Step 5: Grasp the text in our town.**  
How should individual Christians today live out the theological principles?

**Criteria for Principles**

- The principle should be reflected in the text.
- The principle should not be culturally bound.
- The principle should be timeless and not tied to a specific situation.
- The principle should correspond to the teaching of the rest of Scripture.
- The principle should be relevant to both the biblical and the contemporary audience.

Grab your bible and revisit a passage that you've recently read, but now travel through the text as part of the Interpretive Journey. Record your findings in a journal. Prayerfully consider how to live out the theological principle today. Share what you find with someone else.
