**Introduction:**

**I. THE DISCIPLES OF JOHN (vs. 35-39)**

**A. How They Found the Lord (vs. 35-37)**

“again the next day...”

“John was standing with two of his disciples”

“he looked at Jesus as He walked”

“Behold, the Lamb of God!”

“The two disciples heard him speak, and they followed Jesus.”

**B. How They Followed the Lord (vs. 38-39)**

“Jesus turned and saw them following”

“What do you seek?”

“Rabbi, where are You staying? (which translated means Teacher)”

“Come, and you will see.”

“so they came and saw where He was staying and they stayed with Him that day”

“it was about the tenth hour”

## II. THE DISCIPLES OF JESUS (vs. 40-42)

### A. Andrew's Experience (vs. 40-41)

“one of the two who heard John speak and followed Him”

Mark 1:16-20

“Andrew, Simon Peter's brother”

“In bringing his brother Simon Peter to Christ, no man did the church a greater service than Andrew.” – Edwin Blum

“he found first his own brother Simon”

“We have found the Messiah (which translated means Christ).”

### B. Peter's Experience (vs. 42)

“he brought him to Jesus”

“Jesus looked at him and said...”

“You are Simon the son of John; you shall be called Cephas (which is translated Peter).”

**Conclusion:** (borrowed from J.C. Ryle)

- 1) We see what good is done by continually testifying of Christ.
- 2) We see what good a believer may do to others, by speaking to them about Christ.
