Observation-Interpretation- APPLICATION
 APPLICATION: How does the meaning of the text apply to life?

Inductive Application: James 1:22 (NASB) says, "But prove yourselves doers of the word, and not merely hearers who delude themselves." After thorough **observation** and correct **interpretation** (hearing), we come to **application**, which is embracing the truth of God's Word (doing). How does this apply to me? What truths do I take from this passage? What changes do I need to make in my life?

We often jump to application first, but application must be based on accurate observation and correct interpretation. Otherwise, we may embrace legalism or tradition instead of the truth. Application happens as we go before the Lord with the things we have read and carefully studied.

When applying Scripture, ask these questions:

- What does the passage teach? Does it address only specific people or problems? Or is there a broader teaching on the topic?
- Does this passage shed light on your beliefs or behavior patterns? Is there an area of disobedience in your life? Wrong attitudes or motives toward others?
- What does God want to teach you?

When applying Scripture avoid:

- Applying cultural standards over biblical standards. Using Scripture out of context.
- Making Scripture fit our theology. Instead, develop theology in accord with what Scripture says.

The ultimate goal of Inductive Bible Study is to discover truth for yourself, go deeper in your study with others, and disciple others who are seeking the truth. Remember: No matter how much you know about God's Word, if you don't apply what you have learned, your Bible study will not yield spiritual fruit.
