BIBLICAL COUNSELING

For years I had been hesitant to enter into a counselors office. I guess that I had attached a stigma with "going to a counselor" to being someone who was not fit spiritually and thereby shouldn't be a leader, or basically a Christian. You might have similar views of counseling. Today, I want us to think biblically on this and introduces some of you to the world of Biblical counseling.

1 Thessalonians 5:14 "And we urge you brothers, admonish the idle, encourage the faint-hearted, help the weak, be patient with them all."

This is one of the key passages that explain Biblical counseling. The dynamics within this passage introduce us to a depth of personal engagement that aligns with B.C. as a whole.

Consider "**brothers**" and immediately we understand the context is the community of the believers in a local church. B.C. is best demonstrated in a local church.

"**Admonish**" is one of those ancient words filled with much meaning. In the Greek (*noutheteo*) means to instruct, admonish, warn; to have a corrective influence on someone, to impart understanding. Some of you quickly noticed the correlation between the Greek word *noutheteo* and *Nouthetic Counseling* with which you may have some familiarity with. The Baker Encyclopedia of Psychology and Counseling states that "The aim of Nouthetic Counseling is to effect change in the counselee by encouraging greater conformity to the principles of Scripture."

Paul was confident that the Roman believers would be able to engage in this type of counseling as he wrote, "And concerning you, my brethren, I myself also am convinced that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge and able also to **admonish (noutheteo)** one another" (Romans 15:14).

This is a powerful start towards understanding B.C.—God's Word is sufficient for everything in this life. We as the local church can all participate in admonishing or counseling one another with God's Word. Are you ready? Ready yourself by studying the scriptures. All of us can be used of God to admonish, encourage, and help one another patiently with the Word of God.
