Fruit of the Spirit (2 of 2) At-a-Glance

But the **FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT** is... **KINDNESS**

A tender spirit purposefully expressed (Rom. 2:4) and sacrificially given (Eph. 2:7) especially to the undeserving (Titus 3:4).
- To avoid spoiling watch for *a judgmental spirit*.

GOODNESS

A focused resolve (2 Thess. 1:11) that drives us to become actively involved in the life of another (2 Chron. 24:16) consistently expressed through generosity (Neh. 9:25).
- To avoid spoiling watch for *selfishness*.

FAITHFULNESS

A promise (Rom. 3:3; Lam. 3:23) to keep one's word, and do one's best (1 Thess. 1:3) with a servant-attitude focused on the Master's approval (Matt. 25:21)
- To avoid spoiling watch for *weariness, laziness, procrastination and discouragement*.

GENTLENESS

An attitude of humility (Jam. 1:21) stirred by grateful spirit (Num. 12:3) revealed in a tenderness towards others (Eph. 4:2) sustained by a growing trust in God (Matt. 5:5).
- To avoid spoiling watch for *bitterness*.

SELF-CONTROL

The growing realization that one's desire to please self was crucified with Christ, and replaced with a desire to glorify God (Gal. 2:20).
- To avoid spoiling watch for *pride*.

Take time to meditate on the above scriptures and "let the word of Christ dwell in you richly" (Col. 3:16), "be filled with the Holy Spirit" (Eph. 5:18) and bear the "fruit of the Spirit" today.
