“where I am going, you cannot come”

“the Jews were saying, ‘Surely He will not kill Himself, will He, since He says, “Where I am going, you cannot come?””

B. The Passport that Will Get You There (vs. 23-24)

“and He was saying to them, ‘you are from below, I am from above’ ”

“you are of this world, I am not of this world”

“Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins”

“for unless you believe that I am He, you will die in your sins”

II. JESUS’ CLARIFICATION ABOUT HIS DEATH (8:25-29)

A. His Father’s Confirming Testimony (vs. 25-27)

“so they were saying to Him, ‘Who are You?’ ”

“What have I been saying to you from the beginning?”
