I am Joshua Wolanyo Akakpo, born in Togo (West Africa) in 1987, 28th August. I was raised by Christian parents as we lived in five countries (Togo, Ghana, Cameroon, Benin and Nigeria). I finally got an understanding of Salvation and God when I was 16. Being part of my Dad's (Joseph & Francisca with ABWE-GAP) ministry over the years, had helped me to gain a knowledge on the things that concern eternity with Christ. Opportunities for me included

ministries such as AWANA, mission trips, Sunday school teacher, kids programs, Choir, Youth Programs, Youth Camps counselor, kids camps, and many Bible studies. I had planned to become an engineer and go to Japan for my education in Computer Science. Providentially, I received a scholarship from a Christian College in Chicago in 2013 following the completion of my associate Degree in Computer Science in Togo. I decided to take that grace that God was offering me to learn more about Him and serve Him. I initially decided to attend for only two years in Bible Doctrine/Mission but I ended up continuing on through the masters programs in Theology and Bible College Administration. The time at the college was a huge blessing not only for myself but also for my spiritual growth. I have been involved in many activities at the College and outside the college thru Churches I have visited. I am so grateful for those opportunities. It reminds me of whom we belong to and whom we are sons and daughters to; let's just serve Him with everything we have got.
