

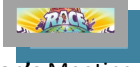

The Star-Spangled Banner

By Francis Scott Key

(Verse 2) Oh! thus be it ever, when freemen shall stand
Between their loved home and the war's desolation!
Blest with victory and peace, may the heav'n rescued land
Praise the Power that hath made and preserved us a nation.
Then conquer we must, when our cause it is just,
And this be our motto: "In God is our trust."
And the star-spangled banner in triumph shall wave
O'er the land of the free and the home of the brave!

Will God bless America? Does America really trust in God? Our neighboring countries express thoughts of God within their anthems. "God keep our land glorious and free! O Canada, we stand on guard for thee." But consider the moral degradation above our northern border and most of us are thankful that we live in the U.S.A. Further, our Mexican neighbors' anthem expresses, "For in heaven your eternal destiny has been written by the hand of God". Would we consider Mexico as submissive to the sovereignty of God? This is unlikely as we see so much corruption and violence emanating from a resource-rich land, governed by hard-hearted leaders. How then, do we understand God's workings with the nations? God orchestrates the nations and also works in the hearts of individuals. "Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord; and the people whom he has chosen for his own inheritance" (Psa. 33:12). God's heart is for the nations and for individual who will submit to his sovereign rule in their lives, beginning with salvation, continuing in the sanctification process over a lifetime and finally displaying his glory ultimately in their glorification.

We must live lives of integrity, witness convincingly and pray passionately if we are to see any semblance of national blessings from our GOD.
