

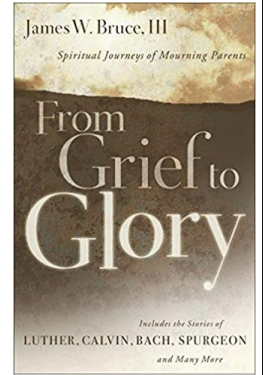

“Death is not a friend to be embraced, but an ugly enemy, a vile intruder into the world. But God...we should give thanks to God, who has conquered death through the resurrection of his Son, Jesus Christ. Because death has no sting or victory over the children of God.”
