

Over the next couple of months, or elders & pastors will be working through theology examinations by group of peers. During this time, we want to introduce you or reintroduce you to the men that will be examined and then officially continue to serve as elders of MFBC.

Randall Keith Cook (Randy) Born: January 17, 1953 Married to Phyllis since 1973

Randy's Testimony (condensed version)

My parents tell me that when I was four years of age I asked Jesus to be my Savior. Shortly after that, my parents moved from Kalispell, Montana to Omaha, Nebraska to attend Omaha Baptist Bible Institute in order to prepare for missionary service in Brazil. On one occasion while in Omaha when I was eight years old, I felt unsure about my salvation and remember praying, "Lord, if I wasn't saved before, then I want to make sure now." After that time I never had any other doubts about my salvation. I was baptized by immersion a year later.

When I was ten, my parents joined ABWE and we moved to Brazil. Until my last year in high school I was not very committed as a Christian. However, during a week of camp when I was a senior, I went forward at the invitation to give my life to God for His purposes. The following year I returned to the U.S. to study at Faith Baptist Bible College in Ankeny, Iowa.

During the Missions Conference my freshman year at college, I decided to return to Brazil to serve the Lord as a missionary. After my sophomore year, I married a pastor's daughter from Idaho—Phyllis Obenchain. Following three years as Youth Pastor at First Baptist Church of Creston, Iowa, we joined ABWE and went to Brazil. Since I was interested in a teaching ministry, we located in Natal where I could be part of the Berean Baptist Seminary and Institute.

During our ten years in Natal, we worked in various ministries. However, most of my time was spent in teaching and Bible school administration. Through interest in the Old Testament and Bible backgrounds and following two trips to Israel, I grew increasingly interested in Jewish evangelism. Since there were very few Jewish people in N Brazil, we applied to ABWE to be transferred to Sao Paulo. In the process (much too long to relate here), we were redirected to Israel instead.

We spent three years in Jerusalem and started a congregation which is continuing today with an Israeli pastor and the help of another ABWE couple....

There's more to story. Since August 2008, Randy has served as senior pastor at Meridian First Baptist Church.

We encourage you to attend our elders' theology exams' and hear each of their testimonies. God is continuing to write a story for each of them and for MFBC as we move forward to God's Glory.
