Michael Munger (Mike)

Hello, My name is **Mike Munger** and I'm better than you. Nobody introduces themselves that way, but it doesn't take long to realize when somebody believes it of themselves.

When someone believes that they've worked hard enough, memorized enough, knows the right answers and (if they don't, can obfuscate enough to get by) done the things they *ought* and haven't the things they *oughtn't* it's readily apparent. It's especially apparent to God who sees the heart (Sam 16:7)

It's a prickly proposition when one decides to compare their **righteousness's** against the Holiness of Almighty God. That is exactly what I foolishly believed, that if I was honest enough to admit it, God was awfully lucky to have my on his team. You can imagine the awkwardness that occurred when I stumbled across *Isaiah 64 that pretty graphically spells out just how our righteousness's stack up against **God's righteousness**.

*"Since ancient times no one has heard,
no ear has perceived,
no eye has seen any God besides you,
who acts on behalf of those who wait for him.*

*You come to the help of those who gladly do right,
who remember your ways. But when we continued to
sin against them, you were angry.*

How then can we be saved?

*All of us have become like one who is unclean, and all
our righteous acts are like filthy rags;
we all shrivel up like a leaf,
and like the wind our sins sweep us away."*

I became convinced that all my knowledge and the good things I'd done (mostly for show) didn't hold a candle to the darkness in my prideful heart. When I really understood what I said I believed all along, I began to understand what **grace** is all about. My good works not only didn't balance out my wickedness, they themselves were like wretched refuse compared to God's standard. I bring nothing to the table, God was willing to step into my haughty heart and rescue me in the midst of my rebellion by taking my sin onto his account and wrapping me in his own perfect **righteousness**.

Grace is getting what you don't deserve, **mercy** is not getting what you deserve; **Both found me**.
