# I. GOD IS SOVEREIGN IN HIS POWER (75:1-3)

A. Congregational Praise (vs. 1)

Thanks for Your Name - "for Your name is near"

Thanks for Your Deeds - "men declare Your wondrous works"

B. Divine Response (vs. 2-3)

"I will judge uprightly."

"I will uphold securely."

A. Divine Declaration (vs. 4-5)

"do not boast"

"do not lift up the horn"

"do not lift up your horn on high"

"do not speak with insolent pride"

B. Congregational Response (vs. 6-8)
