Introduction:

I. THE PEACE THAT ONLY THE LORD GIVES (14:27)

A. An Unconditional Gift

“peace I give to you”

B. An Uncommon Gift

“not as the world gives do I give to you”

C. An Uncomplicated Gift

“Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful.”

II. THE PROMISE THE LORD HAS GIVEN US (14:28-29)

A. His Going is Temporary (vs. 28a)

“You heard that I said to you, ‘I go away, and I will come to you.’”

B. His Coming is Certain (vs. 28b)

“...I will come to you.’ If you loved Me, you would have rejoiced because I go to the Father”

“for the Father is greater than I”

C. His Teaching is Helpful (vs. 29)

“Now I have told you before it happens...”

“...so that when it happens, you may believe.”

III. THE PATTERN THE LORD HAS GIVEN US TO FOLLOW (14:30-31))

A. Resistance to the Devil (vs. 30)

“I will not speak much more with you”

“for the ruler of the world is coming”

“and he has nothing in Me”

B. Obedience to the Father (vs. 31a)

“but so that the world may know that I love the Father...”

“I do exactly as the Father commanded Me”

“Get up, let us go from here.”
