## A CALL FOR GOD TO INTERVENE

## Introduction:

Superscription: "A Song [shir], a Psalm [mizmor] of Asaph"

## I. AN APPEAL TO GOD TO INSPECT (vs. 1-8) - "Lord, see what is happening!"

A. Look at Their Corruption (vs. 1-4)

<sup>1</sup>O God, do not remain quiet; do not be silent and, O God, do not be still.

<sup>2</sup>For behold, Your enemies make an uproar,

And those who hate You have exalted themselves.

<sup>3</sup>They make shrewd plans against Your people and conspire together against Your treasured ones.

<sup>4</sup>They have said, "Come, and let us wipe them out as a nation,

That the name of Israel be remembered no more."

## B. Look at Their Conspiracy (vs. 5-8)

<sup>5</sup>For they have conspired together with one mind; against You they make a covenant:

<sup>6</sup>The tents of Edom and the Ishmaelites, Moab and the Hagrites;

<sup>7</sup>Gebal and Ammon and Amalek, Philistia with the inhabitants of Tyre;

<sup>8</sup>Assyria also has joined with them;

They have become a help to the children of Lot. Selah.

II. AN APPEAL TO GOD TO INTERVENE (vs. 9-18) - "Lord, do	what is necessary!"
A. Defeat Them (vs. 9-12)	
<sup>9</sup> Deal with them as with Midian,	
As with Sisera and Jabin at the torrent of Kishon, who were destroyed at En-dor, who became as dung for the ground.	
<sup>11</sup> Make their nobles like Oreb and Zeeb	
And all their princes like Zebah and Zalmunna,	
<sup>12</sup> Who said, "Let us possess for ourselves the pastures of God."	
B. Destroy Them (vs. 13-15)	"On reflection it may be the voice of a seasoned religion
<sup>13</sup> O my God, make them like the whirling dust,	which knows profoundly what it costs to beat off despair It is an act of profound faith to entrust one's most precious hatreds to God, knowing they will be taken
Like chaff before the wind.	seriously."  - Walter Bruggeman, Message of the Psalms (p. 77)
<sup>14</sup> Like fire that burns the forest And like a flame that sets the mountains on fire,	
<sup>15</sup> So pursue them with Your tempest And terrify them with Your storm.	
C. Disgrace Them (vs. 16-18)	
<sup>16</sup> Fill their faces with dishonor,	
That they may seek Your name, O LORD.	
<sup>17</sup> Let them be ashamed and dismayed forever, and let them be humiliated and perish,	
<sup>18</sup> That they may know that You alone, whose name is the L	ORD, are the Most High over all the earth.
