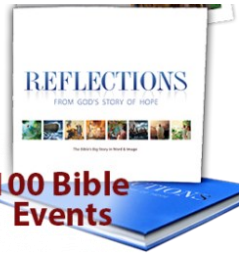

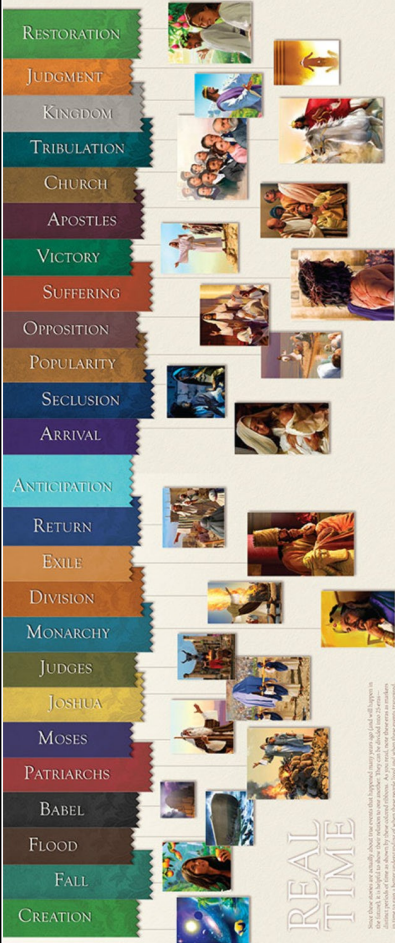
- Thank you for your support in prayer and giving.

“The book you hold in your hands tells true stories about real people living in real places in real time. The events comprise a large part of God’s story of hope starting with the beginning of time and continuing through to the future. You will read happy stories and sad stories; stories of victory and stories of defeat; stories of love and compassion and stories of hatred and deceit; stories of people coming to and having communion with their Creator; stories of people running away from God. But throughout you will see a God who loves people, gives hope, and provides a way back to Him. You will read about issues we all want our children to ponder as they go through life because the stories are about real people and real-life experiences.”



“Since these stories are actually about true events that happened many years ago (and will happen in the future), it is helpful to show their relation to one another. They can be divided into 25 eras—distinct periods of time as shown...”

Consider how you may share God’s Story through the Bible with your friends and family. Maybe a helpful book like this can be a catalyst towards further conversations about the GOSPEL of Jesus Christ.
