I. DAVID'S PRAYER (vs. 1-7)

A. His Appeal (vs. 1-4)

¹Incline Your ear, O LORD, and answer me; for I am afflicted and needy.

²Preserve my soul, for I am a godly man;

O You my God, save Your servant who trusts in You.

³Be gracious to me, O Lord, for to You I cry all day long.

⁴Make glad the soul of Your servant, for to You, O Lord, I lift up my soul.

B. His Assurance (vs. 5-7)

⁵For You, Lord, are good, and ready to forgive,

and abundant in lovingkindness to all who call upon You.

⁶Give ear, O LORD, to my prayer; and give heed to the voice of my supplications!

⁷In the day of my trouble I shall call upon You, for You will answer me.

II. DAVID'S PRAISE (vs. 8-13)

A. His Adoration (vs. 8-10)

8There is no one like You among the gods, O Lord,

nor are there any works like Yours.

⁹All nations whom You have made shall come and worship before You, O Lord, and they shall glorify Your name.

¹⁰For You are great and do wondrous deeds;

You alone are God.

B. His Affirmation (vs. 11-13)

¹¹Teach me Your way, O LORD; I will walk in Your truth;

Unite my heart to fear Your name.

¹²I will give thanks to You, O Lord my God, with all my heart, and will glorify Your name forever.

¹³For Your lovingkindness toward me is great,

and You have delivered my soul from the depths of Sheol.

III. DAVID'S PLEA (vs. 14-17)

A. His Adversaries (vs. 14-15)

¹⁴O God, arrogant men have risen up against me, and a band of violent men have sought my life, and they have not set You before them.

¹⁵But You, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abundant in lovingkindness and truth.

B. His Advantage (vs. 16-17)

¹⁶Turn to me, and be gracious to me;

Oh grant Your strength to Your servant, and save the son of Your handmaid.

¹⁷Show me a sign for good, that those who hate me may see it and be ashamed,

because You, O LORD, have helped me and comforted me.
