

<sup>18</sup> Now the birth of Jesus the Messiah was as follows: when His mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be pregnant by the Holy Spirit. <sup>19</sup> And her husband Joseph, since he was a righteous man and did not want to disgrace her, planned to send her away secretly.<sup>20</sup> But when he had thought this over, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife; for the Child who has been conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit.<sup>21</sup> She will give birth to a Son: and you shall name Him Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins." <sup>22</sup> Now all this took place so that what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet would be fulfilled: <sup>23</sup> "BEHOLD, THE VIRGIN WILL CONCEIVE AND GIVE BIRTH TO A Son, and they shall name HIM IMMANUEL," which translated means, "God with us." <sup>24</sup> And Joseph awoke from his sleep and did as the angel of the Lord commanded him, and took Mary as his wife, <sup>25</sup> but kept her a virgin until she gave birth to a Son; and he named Him Jesus. Ecclesiastes 3:1a For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven...

Within the seasons, we experience the goodness of God for we are held within their scope of order in creation. Not only do we see the climatic effects of the seasons, but the LORD instituted times of REFLECTION, **REJOICING, REDEMPTION, RENEWAL** and **REST** throughout the calendar year for His people.

We celebrated (REJOICING) to teach our children that God is the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, that He redeemed our Jewish people at Passover and later sent the Messiah to redeem (**REDEMPTION**) everyone, Jews and Gentiles, from sin (RENEWAL & REST)."

What a wonderful reason for the season, as expressed by righteous and devout Simeon shortly after the birth of Christ. "For my eyes' have seen your salvation which you have prepared for in the sight of all people, a light for revelation to the Gentiles and for glory to your people Israel." Luke 2:30-32
