Romans 4:13-17

¹³ For the promise to Abraham or to his
descendants that he would be heir of
the world was not through the Law,
but through the righteousness of
faith. ¹⁴ For if those who are of the
Law are heirs, then faith is made void
and the promise is nullified; ¹⁵ for the
Law brings about wrath, but where
there is no law, there also is no
violation.

¹⁶ For this reason *it is* by faith, in order
that *it may be* in accordance
with grace, so that the promise will be
guaranteed to all the descendants, not
only to those who are of the Law, but
also to those who are of the faith of
Abraham, who is the father of us
all, ¹⁷ (as it is written: "I HAVE MADE
YOU A FATHER OF MANY NATIONS")
in the presence of Him whom he be-
lieved, *that is*, God, who gives life to
the dead and calls into being things
that do not exist.

Section D. Receiving Members

1. Candidates may qualify to become
members of the church in one of two ways:

a. Interview with the elders and
Baptism by immersion at Meridian First
Baptist Church.

b. Statement of Christian experience
and interview with designated elders. (having
been previously baptized by immersion as a
believer).

2. Prospective applicants for membership
shall be published two weeks prior to the vote.
If one or more members, because of the
knowledge of some existing circumstance,
deem it necessary to object to an applicant, a
written objection shall be brought in person to
the elders for examination. The elders shall
examine the accusation to determine validity.

3. After a recommendation by the elders,
applicants shall be affirmed by a vote of the
congregation at any Sunday service or
business meeting of the church and shall be
accepted upon approval of a majority of
present, voting members.
