- Pray for additional supporters Our support level is around 77%. While that is wonderful news and we are grateful for each gift and giver, we would ask that you join us in praying for additional ministry partners.

BIBLICAL COUNSELING

Biblical Counseling Addresses the Heart

Just "follow your heart". This is bad counsel, yet widely promoted in songs, movies, etc. Why is this bad? Well, it puts you in the center of your life— you're elevated & exalted. Also, biblically, we understand that your heart is evil. Your heart is deceptive. The prophet, Jeremiah tells us, "*The heart is deceitful above all things and desperately wicked, who can understand it?*" You and I don't realize the depth of deception and wickedness that resides in our hearts. How can we? Well, in the next verse, Jeremiah tells us, "*I the Lord search the heart, I test the mind, even to give every man according to his ways, according to the fruit of his doings*" (Jer. 17:10).

- Here are some helpful questions to ask, concerning your heart: (List of questions adapted from *One-Eighty Ministries*)
- What do you want, desire, seek, aim for, pursue, hope for?
 - What are your goals, expectations, intentions?
 - What do you feel like doing? Do you want what you want, or do you want Christ's lordship over your life?
 - Where do you look for security, meaning, happiness, fulfillment, joy, or comfort? Where do you put your 'basic trust'?
 - What would make you happy?
 - What do you fear? What do you tend to worry about?
 - What do you love and hate most of all?
 - How do you define success or failure in a particular situation?
 - What image do you have of who you are? Ought to be or want to be?
 - At your deathbed what to you would sum up your life as worthwhile?
 - What do you see as your rights?
 - When you are pressured or tense, where do you turn? What do you think about?
 - What do you pray for?

Take time to allow God to search your heart and then go to his Word, which can give you clear assessment and direction. "*For the Word of God is living and powerful, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intentions of the heart*" (Heb. 4:12).
