### Gleanings from our Seasons



"The holiday got started on May 30, 1868, when Union General John A. Logan declared the day an occasion to decorate the graves of Civil War soldiers. Twenty years later, the name was changed to *Memorial Day*. On May 11, 1950, Congress passed a resolution requesting that the President issue a proclamation calling on Americans to observe each Memorial Day as a day of prayer for permanent peace and designating a period on that day when the people of the United States might unite in prayer. President Richard M. Nixon declared Memorial Day a federal holiday in 1971. Memorial Day is now observed on the last Monday of May. It is an occasion to honor the men and women who died in all wars" ( www.TimeforKids.com ).

Within the fabric of American history, we have cherished words like, *honor, sacrifice, united, liberty, peace,* etc. Much of what is commemorated on Memorial Day is conveyed by the same words.
