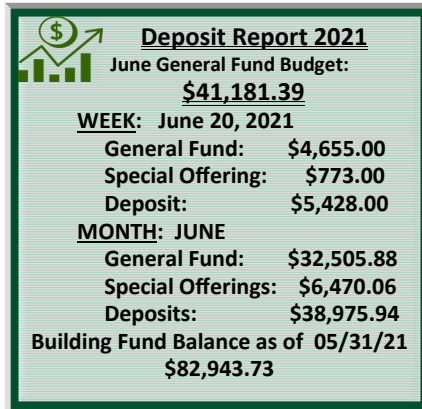

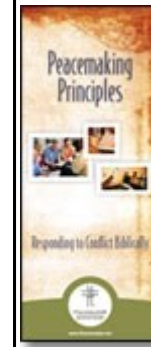

### THE SEVEN A'S OF CONFESSION

*Matt. 7:3-5; 1 John 1:8-9; Prov. 28:13*

**ADDRESS** everyone involved

**AVOID** if, but, and maybe

**ADMIT** specifically

**ACKNOWLEDGE** the hurt

**ACCEPT** the consequences

**ALTER** your behavior

**ASK** for forgiveness

### THE FOUR PROMISES OF FORGIVENESS

- I will not dwell on this incident.
- I will not bring this incident up and use it against you.
- I will not talk to others about this incident.
