#### I. HE WANTS TO DESTROY THE TRUTH OF GOD'S WORD (Genesis 3:1-7)

Exposition:	Observations:
<ul> <li>Satan always attempts to put God's Word in a negative light. (vs. 1-3)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>through sensualism</li> </ul>
Satan categorically contradicts God's Word. (vs. 4)	<ul> <li>through reationalism</li> </ul>
Satan impugns God's motive and character. (vs. 5)	through existentialism
<ul> <li>Satan seeks to control our thinking and then uses us to pull others down. (vs. 6)</li> </ul>	

### II. HE WANTS TO DISCREDIT THE TESTIMONY OF GOD'S PEOPLE (II Corinthians 11:1-5, 14-15)

Exposition:	Observations:
<ul> <li>he is the master deceiver and imitator ("disguises himself as an angel of light")</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>through situationalism</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>in the church, he does this through false teachers ("disguised as servants of righteousness")</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>through individualism</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>the result is the necessity of evaluating and making judgments resulting in division or discipline</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>through isolationism</li> </ul>
• the absolute standard is the Word of God

## III. HE WANTS TO DESTROY THE BELIEVER'S ENTHUSIASM FOR GOD (I John 2:7-17)

Exposition:	Observations:
<ul> <li>it's the Evil One (vs. 14) who is the enemy of our souls and works unceasingly destroy us</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>through pessimism</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>he has developed a whole world system ("the things of the world") to use in his attack</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>through defeatism</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>the result is "walking in darkness" (the opposite is "abiding in the Light")</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>through negativism</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>we are strong against his attacks when "the word of God abides in us" (vs. 14)</li> </ul>	

#### IV. HE WANTS TO DILUTE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE LOCAL CHURCH (II Thessalonians 2:1-12)

Exposition:	<b>Observations</b> :
Satan is defined by lawlessness (vs. 7)	through cultism
<ul> <li>his activity is characterized by "signs and false wonders" (vs. 9)</li> </ul>	• through egoism
<ul> <li>those who do not "receive the love of the truth" will be deluded by his influence and end up "believing what is false" (vs. 11)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>through antagonism</li> </ul>
• this is called "taking pleasure in wickedness" and	

will end in their judgment (vs. 12)
