Introduction:

I. THE VERDICT OF THE SANHEDRIN (vs. 1)

A. The Consultation (vs. 1a)

“Early in the morning [they]...held a consultation”

B. The Council (vs. 1b)

“the chief priests with the elders and scribes and the whole Council”

C. The Crime (vs. 1c)

“binding Jesus, they led Him away and delivered Him to Pilate”

John 18:28-30

II. THE HEARING BEFORE PILATE (vs. 2-5)

A. The Accusation (vs. 2-3)

“Pilate questioned Him, ‘Are You the King of the Jews?’ ”

“And He answered him, ‘*It is as you say.*’ ” (John 18:34)

“The chief priests began to accuse Him harshly.”

B. The Answer (vs. 4-5)

“Then Pilate questioned Him again, saying, ‘Do You not answer?’ ” (Isaiah 53:7)

“ ‘See how many charges they bring against You!’ ” (Luke 23:2)

“But Jesus made no further answer...”

“so Pilate was amazed.” (John 18:34-38)

C. Parenthesis: Jesus Before Herod Antipas (Lk. 23:6-12)

III. THE SENTENCING FROM PILATE (vs. 6-15)

A. The Proposal (vs. 6-11)

“Now at the feast he used to release for them any one prisoner whom they requested.”

“The man named Barabbas had been imprisoned with the insurrectionists who had committed murder in the insurrection.”

“The crowd went up and began asking him to do as he had been accustomed to do for them.”

“Pilate answered them, saying, ‘Do you want me to release for you the King of the Jews?’”

“For he was aware that the chief priests had handed Him over because of envy.”

“But the chief priests stirred up the crowd to ask him to release Barabbas for them instead.”

B. The Problem (vs. 12-14)

“Answering again, Pilate said to them, ‘Then what shall I do with Him whom you call the King of the Jews?’”

“They shouted back, ‘Crucify Him!’ ”

“But Pilate said to them, ‘Why, what evil has He done?’ ”

“But they shouted all the more, ‘Crucify Him!’ ”

C. The Pusillanimity (vs. 15)

“Wishing to satisfy the crowd, Pilate released Barabbas for them” (Matthew 27:24)

“and after having Jesus scourged, he handed Him over to be crucified.”
