I. CAMPING AT THE BASE OF THE MOUNTAIN (vs. 1-6)

"after the sons of Israel had gone out of the land of Egypt"

"the mountain" (Exodus 3:12)

"bore you on eagles' wings" (Deuteronomy 32:11)

"if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant"

"you shall be My own possession"

"a kingdom of priests"

"a holy nation"

Question: Why did God choose Israel? (Deuteronomy 7:6-11)

II. CLIMBING UP TO THE TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN (vs. 7-9)

"Moses...set before them all these words which the LORD had commanded him"

"All that the LORD has spoken we will do!" (Exodus 24:1-8)

Deuteronomy 5:28-29

"Moses brought back the words of the people to the LORD"

"I will come to you in a thick cloud..." (Deuteronomy 4:11-12)

"so that the people may hear when I speak with you and may also believe in you forever"

Question: What is required to stand before the Lord? (Psalm 15)

Conclusion: If God has spoken, we must...

- 1) hear what He has said
- 2) seek to understand everything we can of what He has said
- 3) obey immediately
- 4) grow deeper in our understanding and obedience
- 5) bear witness to others of what He says
