“set bounds for the people all around”

“do not go up...or touch”

“no hand shall touch him...”

“When the ram’s horn sounds a long blast, they shall come up to the mountain.”

*yovel vs. shofar*

“they shall come up”

**IV. CONSECRATION BEFORE THE MOUNTAIN** (vs. 14-19)

“thunder...lightning flashes...and a thick cloud”

“very loud trumpet sound...grew louder and louder”

“all the people...trembled”

“Moses brought the people out...to meet God”

“Moses spoke and God answered”

**V. COMING DOWN TO THE MOUNTAIN** (vs. 20-25)
